Shirts should have collars or dressy necklines. Shirts/tops may not have spaghetti straps, open sides or midriff showing. Shirts with offensive logos or language are not appropriate. Nice shoes even open toed shoes, flip flops, and nice tennis shoes are appropriate. Undergarments are not to be exposed.
