Sample Style Revue Contest Entry Narratives

Example 1: What to wear for dressy occasions won't be a problem for Mary Smith of the Dodge Clovers 4-H Club. He completes his outfit with his trusty cowboy boots. A member of the Curious Clover 4-H Club and the Super Livestock 4-H Club, he has been in 4-H five years. This year his projects included rabbits, dairy, and creative costume.

The 100% polyester fabric is easy care, withstands the activity of a cheerleader. Chris has personalized her outfit with her school emblem.
