## JUNIOR FAIR FAVORITE FOODS CONTEST RULES & GUIDELINES

**\*Any Junior Fair exhibitor may enter the contest \* Exhibitors do not need to be enrolled in a 4-H food project\***

### Favorite Food General Contest Guidelines:

- ANY Junior Fair Exhibitor (4-H, FFA, or FCCLA) is eligible to participate in the Favorite Foods Contest. Entry forms due by the Thursday before fair (may be turned in at 4-H project judging)
- All participants will receive a \$3.00 premium

### Favorite Food Contest

- Contest will be broken down into two age divisions: Junior (8-13) and Senior (14+) as of January 1
- Participants will be interviewed for 5 to 6 minutes to evaluate their knowledge of the product and preparation
- Entries will be judged on both interview skills and quality of food product
- 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place rosettes and honorable mention (if applicable) will be awarded: 1<sup>st</sup> place contestants in each category will receive an additional award
- **New for 2022- Participants must bring:**
  - **Favorite food prepared (2 or more servings)**
  - **A serving utensil**
  - **One copy of recipe**
  - **No longer need tableware, tablecloth, menu, or centerpiece**
- Participants choose one or more of the following categories:
  - Appetizer
  - Main Dish
  - Dessert
  - Healthy Living (Something promoting a healthy lifestyle choice or a medical need such as gluten free, low carb, sugar free, etc.)

### Crawford County Bake Off Contest

- Participants will bring baked product and leave it to be judged- no interview will be conducted.
  - *Suggested to use throw away plates/ containers so youth don't forget to pick up after contest.*
- Entries will be judged on quality standards for product such as appearance, texture, flavor, and presentation
- 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place rosettes and honorable mention (if applicable) will be awarded
- No stipulations on what recipe is used as long as it fits into the appropriate age division
- Age divisions:
  - **Junior Division (8-11)**- 4 brownies on a plate or container
  - **Intermediate Division (12-14)**- 6 cupcakes on a plate or container
  - **Senior Division (15+)** - 1 pie in pan

### Cloverbud Division

- Cloverbud members can participate for fun and receive a \$3.00 premium for participation.
- The yearly mandatory theme for 2022 is COOKIES! Cloverbuds must use that theme in ANY recipe they choose.
- Judge will taste their food, ask a few questions, and then the participant will be awarded. *No recipe copy or serving ware needed.*
- Participants can take their food home immediately after "*judging*" or stay for the end of the contest "*feast*", where participants share what they have made with others.
