
I hope everyone had a wonderful holiday season and a good start to the New Year! As we start the 4-H year, consider trying something new in 2022!

Enrollment deadline is APRIL 1, 2022

Youth interested in joining 4-H after the April deadline will be deemed non-competitive and are not eligible for awards (trophies, rosettes, certificates) at the 4-H pre-fair judging, the Crawford County Fair, or state fair. Members may have projects evaluated (for A, B, or C ribbons), exhibit projects at the fair, and receive a premium.
