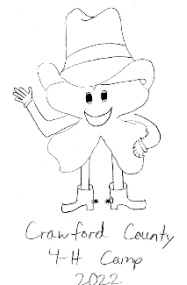

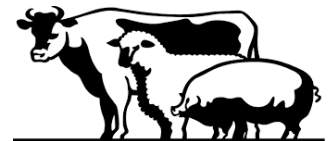

- Pre-Fair Project Requirements
  - If you haven't already, BE SURE to look at the county project requirements & display information on our website under family handbook: <https://crawford.osu.edu/program-areas/4-h-youth-development/member-forms-applications>
- Fair Week Awards
  - Don't forget: Exhibitors receiving a trophy, plaque or any other special class winner award **MUST** present a completed award thank you note, for the award donor, to a member of the Jr. Fair Board before they can receive their award. *Award donors may choose to present their award to the winning exhibitor or exhibitors may use award for pictures, however the award must be given back to the Jr. Fair Board until a thank you note is completed.*
- Vouchers
  - During the fair, vouchers are given to exhibitors as their premium for displaying their project or participating in contests. These must be claimed by the exhibitor (or parent/ guardian) and can be cashed at times listed on voucher. No money will be given for vouchers after the last voucher time on Saturday, July 23.
- Thank You's
  - A lot of hard work and money goes into making the fair & 4-H year a success. Consider writing a thank you note to advisors, sale buyers, book sponsors, and other community members/ businesses that make our fair great!
- 4-H Food Stand
  - We are excited to announce that 4-H will be teaming up with Lykens Volunteer Fire Department to run our food stand in 2022. Using the Lykens Food Stand building & tent, Lykens will continue to serve their amazing breakfast and at 11a 4-H will take over for lunch and dinner.
