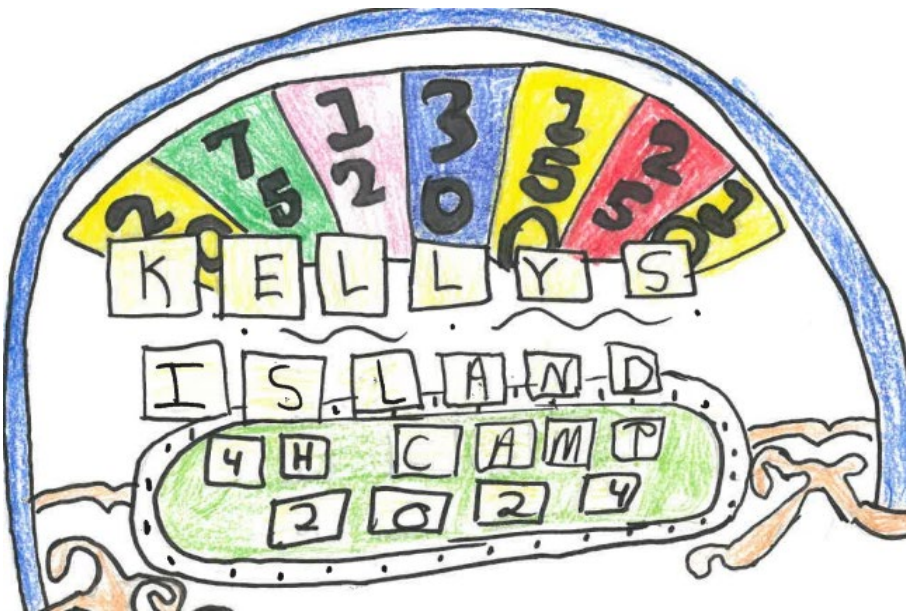

Livestock DUNF Help Sheet

Drug Use Notification Forms (DUNF) are due prior to unloading ALL MARKET ANIMALS- NOT BREEDING.

The link for DUNF forms will go live approximately one month prior to fair. It's encouraged not to complete the DUNF until 2-3 days prior to fair move in.

If you submit a DUNF form and realize you have made a mistake, submit a second form with the correct information or contact Allison to make edits to the original form.

Remember this form indicates if an animal has medication CURRENTLY, not has the animal ever had medication.

Crawford County Fair Online DUNF (Drug Use Notification Form) Help Sheet

ODA Drug Use Notification Form. This form is required for ALL MARKET & CURRENTLY LACTATING animals exhibited through the Jr. Fair.

ALL DUNF FORMS MUST BE COMPLETED **BEFORE UNLOADING**

Livestock exhibitors will be required to complete one DUNF form for EACH MARKET ANIMAL (or lactating animal) brought to the fairgrounds. Be sure to have the following information ready for submission:

- Beef Department: You will need to report your fair tag number
- Swine Department: You will need the ear notch numbers you submitted in May
- Poultry Department: Enter one DUNF form per pen. For ID, list the class number you will be showing (150CM- Roaster, 150CM- Broiler, or 150TM/ DO NOT submit exhibition animals)
- Rabbit Department: You will enter the tattoo number submitted on entry form
- Goat & Sheep Department: You will need the full Scrapies tag number AND county tag number. The scrapies ID will begin with 2 letter state identifier followed by numbers then put a backslash followed by county tag number (example: OH1234-5678/ 57)
- Dairy Department: You will need your farm ID tag number
- Alpaca Department: DOES NOT SUBMIT DUNF FORM

All exhibitors should mark YES to attending an Ohio approved Quality Assurance Program this year- if you didn't you would have received an ineligible to show letter

Under the drug treatment record portion, it will ask "Is the above listed animal free of medication"? This means is the animal drug free AT THE TIME OF FAIR

- If it is drug free by fair, enter yes to complete the survey
- If it is NOT drug free by fair, enter no and provide the treatment information
 - Treatment Date
 - Condition being Treated
 - Name of Medication
 - Amount
 - Route
 - Withdrawl Time
 - Withdrawl Date
 - RX or Extra Label?
 - If yes, YOU MUST ENTER YOUR VETERINARIAN'S INFORMATION

If ANY of the above information comes back as "flagged" or incorrect, you will be contacted and this information MUST be corrected by specie show day to be eligible for show & sale



Jr. Fair Livestock Entry Reminder

All animals that have not already been identified by the livestock committee (**All Rabbits, All Poultry, All Dairy, and Any Specie Breeding Project**) MUST submit their Jr. Fair Livestock Fair Entry paperwork by June 20, 2024.

The form is available on paper version or online at <https://go.osu.edu/cclivestockentry>
After 11:59 p.m. June 20th, exhibitors must hand deliver entry with a \$25 late fee to OSUE Staff during business hours or by noon June 29th at skillathon.

NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER JUNE 29 FOR ANY REASON AND YOU WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE FOR EXHIBITION AT FAIR.

Livestock Quality Assurance

Regardless of the QAP program youth choose to participate in, ALL Livestock QAP trainings must be completed by May 31st to be eligible for BOTH County & State Fair

ALL livestock exhibitors who have not previously tested out of QAP will need to complete ONE of the following program options:

- Crawford County event
- Ohio 4-H approved event (another county, Beef Expo, etc)

Upcoming Livestock Dates

Swine

- Market Barrows & Gilts must be in exhibitors possession and ear notch information due by May 3rd go.osu.edu/cchogearnotch

Dairy Feeders

- April 15th- May 15th Calves need to be castrated, dehorned, and vaccinated. Keep documentation from veterinarian for verification.

Beef Feeders

- All Beef Feeders must have health papers of recorded vaccines; must be within 30 days of fair
- Must be castrated and dehorned by May 1st
- June 8th Beef Feeder possession and tag day; committee will go to exhibitors home (Exhibitors need to respond to email sent 4/24)

Poultry

All poultry projects are not to be older than dates below & should be less than one year old from show date.

- Week of May 12th -Hatch week for Roasters
- Week of June 2nd -Hatch week for Broilers

Rabbits

- May 1-10 market rabbit suggested birth dates to be fair eligible; Committee will schedule time to come check nesting boxes
- Possession date for rabbits is June 1st

Sheep & Goats

- Goats must be born by December 15th or later
- May 4th Goat and Lamb tag day at fairgrounds 8:00-9:30 a.m.

Alpacas

- The 4-H animals and/or lease agreements must be in the exhibitor's hands by April 15th
