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## General Notes/Guidelines:

- Complete project book and bring required items.
- Clothing Projects bring pattern to judging and model garment for judging. Food & Nutrition Projects see pages 10 and 11 in the 2018 4-H Family Handbook that can be access online at <http://crawford.osu.edu> (Go to Program Areas; then to 4-H Youth Development; then 4-H Family Handbook; then What Do I Need For Judging) for detailed judging requirements
- All other 4-H Project guidelines may be found at website listed. Follow same path as noted above.

## Dress Code Guidelines:

- Since judging is a learning experience of presentation of both yourself and your project, please keep in mind that clothing needs to be appropriate. Appropriate clothing for this judging and other non-livestock programs, contests and awards program will be: nice jeans, docker style pants, capris, shorts, dresses or skirts longer than your fingertips at your sides. Shirts should have collars or dressy necklines. Shirts/tops may not have spaghetti straps, open sides or midriff showing. Shirts with offensive logos or language are not appropriate. Nice shoes even open toed shoes, flip flops, and nice tennis shoes are appropriate. Undergarments are not to be exposed.

## State Fair Winner Guidelines:

To stay somewhat consistent with the Ohio State Fair, all beginner and intermediate food level projects may be awarded one Junior participant (ages 8-13) and one Senior participant (age 14-18) if the project is deemed valid for State Fair competition. State Fair will only accept one advanced food level project entry per project for State Fair.

Jr. = ages 13 and younger

Sr. = ages 14 and older
