Gets the attention of the audience. Arrangement & Use of Equipment: Right equipment for the job. Uses it correctly. Audience can see what 4-H'er is doing. Visual Aids: Equipment, models, charts, and supplies effective and well arranged. Chose the teaching aid to best tell the story. Charts and models neat, concise, large enough, & appropriate. Visual aids utilized in presentation. Logical Sequence: Well organized, clear, logical steps. Evidence shows the 4-H'er has planned presentation. Ability to Work Easily & Efficiently: Steps, illustrative material, and explanation coordinated. Talks about what he/she is showing and explains the procedure. Information given fills time during the process or is related to what is being shown. Summary: Key points summarized. Reliable sources used and cited.</p>
